Director, Priority Capital Programs – Anthony G. Cracchiolo, P.E.

Anthony G. Cracchiolo became the Director of Priority Capital Programs in January 1999. In this position he leads a team of Port Authority and contractor staff to design, build, operate, and maintain two airport access projects that will link Newark International Airport and John F. Kennedy International Airport to the regional transportation network.

During his 32 years of service with the Port Authority he has held a variety of positions managing capital projects at Port Authority facilities, including JFK, Newark International and LaGuardia Airports, Trans-Hudson Tunnels and Bridges, the Mid-town Manhattan Bus Terminal and the World Trade Center. While serving as Assistant Director of the World Trade Department he was responsible for the restoration and renovation of the WTC VISTA Hotel after the 1993 bombing.

In addition to his work experience, Anthony Cracchiolo holds a Bachelor of Science in Civil Engineering, a Master of Science in Transportation Planning & Engineering and is a licensed Professional Engineer in the states of New York and New Jersey. He is a member of the American Society of Civil Engineers, the National Society of Professional Engineers and the Moles.
